The sustainable development challenge and the SMEs

The international community has a crucial challenge to meet by following the UN's 2030 Agenda and its 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) to transform the way we live and do business and change the course of the environmental, social and economic problems of our time. The private sector is an essential part of these solutions and SMEs, which represent 99.8% of business in Europe, are a key part of this sustainable change but often lack the tools and knowledge to make it happen.

The SME Green Skills HUB solution

The Erasmus+ SME Green Skills HUB project aims to support and guide SMEs in the implementation of SDGs, promoting green sectorial skills through innovative and new generation training approaches using gamification and workplace learning pedagogies with the guidance of VET teachers, trainers, and mentors. By doing so, SMEs will experience sustainable change, moving from transactional to transformational partnerships, exploring new frameworks and approaches to measuring impact or finding meaningful ways of working with local communities.

The training resources

SME Green Skills HUB will design a **European Framework of Competencies** to implement the SDGs in SMEs through VET teachers, trainers and mentors that work with the staff of these businesses. Innovative training modules and Vocational Open Online Courses will be available for stakeholders in a **Virtual Campus** as well as a **Mobile Assessment App**, a practical and innovative ICT-based tool designed to evaluate the competences on the implementation of the SDGs in SMEs. The **Guidelines** to promote transparency and recognition of skills to implement SDGs in SMEs will be addressed to VET trainers and SMEs staff throughout Europe.
