Supporting the implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals in Small and Medium-sized Enterprises through VET

The pilot phase of the SME Green Skills HUB is underway

The pilot phase of the SME Green Skills HUB project has already started. It will be carried out in **4 countries**: Spain, Italy, Portugal and Turkey.

The project products to be tested during this pilot phase are now available in all languages of the consortium: the **Virtual Campus** and the **Assessment App**.

During the pilot the following target groups of the project will be involved: **Vocational Education and Training teachers, trainers, consultants and mentors (target Users); and Staff from Small and Medium Sized Enterprises (target Beneficiaries)**.

The target users will test and evaluate the project products, mainly the Virtual Campus and the Assessment App. Then they will apply the knowledge and skills acquired in their work with the target beneficiaries.

The partners will collect feedback from both groups during the piloting, in order to evaluate the products and their usefulness and relevance in relation to the project objective: support the implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals in Small and Medium Sized Enterprises through Vocational Education and Training.

SME Green Skills HUB is a project funded by the European Commission through the Erasmus+ program, involving 6 organizations from 5 countries (Spain, Portugal, Italy, Turkey and Ireland) that started in September 2020 and will finalize in August 2023.

SME Green Skills HUB is a project aimed at assisting and guiding Small and Medium-Sized Enterprises in the implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals by fostering green sectorial skills through innovative and new generation training methods using gamification and workplace learning pedagogies with the guidance of VET teachers, trainers, and mentors. SMEs will experience sustainable change as a result of this, moving from transactional to transformational partnerships, exploring new methods and approaches to measuring impact or finding meaningful ways to collaborate with local communities.
