## Broadcast events in several European cities mark the culmination of the SME Green Skills Hub project

After the successful implementation of the pilot phase, the partners of SME Green Skills HUB will hold the project dissemination events in all participant countries: Spain, Italy, Ireland, Portugal and Turkey.

The **final Multiplier Conference** of the project will be held in Valladolid, Spain, the **15th of June 2023**, aimed at presenting the project results and achievements to relevant national and international stakeholders.

This event will include dynamic sessions to explain the project results: the European Framework of Competencies to implement the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in SMEs, the Virtual Campus, the Assessment App and the Guidelines to promote transparency and recognition of skills to implement SDGs in SMEs. Furthermore the event will serve to promote exploitation and networking possibilities, exchange on practices, cooperation and development of further projects.

During the event the partners will share with leading professionals a dialogue on the importance and influence of the SDGs on SMEs, local authorities and territorial development, as well as present the conclusions of the project and the results of its pilot test.

The **dissemination events in Italy, Ireland, Portugal and Turkey** will be held in the following weeks. More information will be available on the project site and social networks.
